Screening tests are an important part of your preventive health care. The tests can be used for early detection of some of the more common and potentially deadly diseases, such as cancers, diabetes, and heart disease. These tests can find certain illnesses in their earliest and most curable stages, even before you notice symptoms.

Screening Tests for Adults (50 and Up)

Biopsy samples are sent to a laboratory for analysis where experts determine whether the cells are cancerous. A biopsy sample is also analyzed to determine the type of cells involved in the breast cancer, the aggressiveness (grade) of the cancer, and whether the cancer cells have hormone receptors or other receptors that may influence your treatment options.
