A word has typically three parts; namely its (1) sound, its (2) denotation, and its (3) connotation. A word's denotative meaning is its basic meaning as you would typically find in a dictionary. Apart from its denotation(s) a word may also have connotative meaning (s). The denotation for "red" is the color it represents.
